	<i>Data for the entire tree flora of Greece are currently being collected and evaluated along with information on phenology (flowering and fruiting seasons), masting, dispersal, seed/fruit biometrics, seed germination and seed storability (Daskalakov & Thanos 2013, in press). This database constitutes a management tool for the ex situ conservation of the 106 taxa examined (80 trees, 10 taxa usually growing as trees but also occurring as shrubs in the field and 16 taxa reported as shrubs or small trees).</i>
	<i>Data were collected from botanical literature and experimental study for each tree taxon; introduced in a spreadsheet database (Microsoft Office Excel 2007), that is continuously enriched with new experimental results and updated with new scientific knowledge.</i>
